Paradise Flowers workshop.

This workshop is a flower factory.

You will never need to look for a flower pattern again ... create your own and you will find ideas galore as to how to use them ... single blooms or arranged in multiples for embroidery, patchwork, quilting, trapunto, stencilling and stained glass.

No artistic skills are required and by machine the sewing is easy. This is a technique based workshop.... we will not be trying to make an item but we will be learning the design method and sewing techniques (by stitching samples) to be used to make something worthwhile later at home. (Suitable for all levels)

Requirements each participant should bring.....

- Scrap paper ... A4 photocopying size... several sheets ... unlined.
- Mechanical lead pencil.
- Ruler with printed grid. (both long and short rotary cutting rulers and squares are useful)
- Soft eraser.
- Black felt pen ... medium tip.... the kind the kids use !
- Normal sewing kit ..
- Sewing machine in good working order fitted with an open toe embroidery foot, and mid grey thread in both bobbin and on top reel.
- Several large scraps of cotton fabric for trying out the sewing techniques.
- Freezer paper
- Cereal cardboard circles drawn around a dinner plate, saucer, and egg cup.

I look forward to meeting you and I can guarantee a satisfying workshop and the start of a flower filled sewing future !



Pieceful Scenes





'Pieceful' Scenes Workshop Requirements List.

Each participant should bring:

- -A mechanical lead pencil.... The fine lead aids accuracy.
- -Medium tipped black felt pen ...(.the sort that kids use nothing fancy..)
- -Soft eraser.
- -A long transparent ruler which has a grid printed on it..... a Rotary cutting ruler if fine Additional gridded rotary cutting squares / short rulers can also be very useful.
- -Unlined scrap paper for experimentation.
- -Freezer paperminimum size 16 in \times 16 in \times approx 40 cm...from a roll, (not photocopy paper wrappers).
- -Sewing machine in good working order fitted with an open toe presser foot (see pic) with mid grey coloured thread in both the bobbin and on the top reel. Size 60 needle best choice but not essential.



- -Scissors for cutting both fabric and paper.
- -Travelling Iron and board....queues for shared irons use up too much valuable time.
- -Long fine pins ... flat flower pins are ideal.
- -Fabric for samples.... two contrasting coloured large pieces
- Scrap fabrics (12ins / approx 30cm ish' .. ideally plains or small patterns)
- (An optional sewing aid will be demonstrated and offered at £2 cost)

This is an intensive but enjoyable workshop and if the term 'designing' is worrying you...... it shouldn't be!

'Five Dot Flowers 'Workshop.

Requirements List. Each participant should bring.....

- -Scissors for paper and small sharp fabric scissors.
- -Fine tip black felt pen... (kid's kind, nothing fancy)
- -Several sheets of scrap paper.
- -Approx. Min. size 15in/40cm. sheet of Freezer paper.
- -1/4 met. 'Bondaweb' ('Wonder Under' or 'Vliesofix 'in some countries).
- -Teflon pressing sheet / or sheet of non-stick tin foil /baking parchment)
- -Sewing machine capable of doing a very small Zig Zag stitch.
- Transparent (monofilament) thread.
- Normal sewing kit.
- Rotary cutter, board and ruler.



- -An open toe machine foot as pictured.
- -Travel Iron & ironing pad (Hard surface not bouncy is best. A covered piece of cardboard is ideal.). Queues at shared iron wasted valuable time.
- -Fabric: We will be making samples of techniques. Please bring a minimum of two flower colours and two background colours ... fat quarters or large scraps. (an assortment is great)

We will design and work on a cushion sized block to learn the technique. The design and therefore the fabric requirements are completely flexible and variations will be encouraged.

This fun workshop will hopefully get your designing juices going but if you've never designed before do not panic, you will love finding out just how easy it is!
