### Windows of synagogues from Czechoslovakia

We helped arrange a quilt exhibition for a group of Czech quilters to exhibit in Heichal Shlomo, Jerusalem in September 2023. Our friend Hanna Ron met this group when exhibiting at the "Brno Quilt Festival". This group of quilters was very impressed with the restoration of old synagogues in Czechoslovakia and decided to take upon themselves to make quilts of different windows of synagogues all over Czechoslovakia. They felt that windows are "a long-time symbol of interconnection, openness and even desire. It is through a window of any shape and size that we realize a variety of 'watching-related activities' – staring, glimpsing, glancing, viewing... Window is a source of light, warmth and air."

We were very happy to assist them and look forward to future collaborations. We are always looking to exhibit patchworks, for the community to recognize quilting as a craft. Every venue that is willing to exhibit our works is another door opening for the future.
